Belgaum Fort 2.5 km from JNMC





Tip: Guided tours are available on weekends.




It is a popular food court in Belagavi and a haven for food lovers. It is known for serving multiple flavourful delicious North Indian, South Indian and Chinese cuisines

Kittur Fort and Palace: The fort was built by Allappa Gowda Sardesai, the ruler of the Desai dynasty between 1650 and 1681. It holds historical importance due to the Kittur, Uprising against British rule led by Rani Chennamma. The palace and fort are worth exploring to understand the region's past. Fort Lake 3 km from JNMC



Located right next to the Belgaum Fort, lies a beautiful lake also known as Kote Kere. Perfect for morning walks and evening visits with family. This well-maintained lake has boating facilities

Tip: The place is open on all days from 4:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m.





Mahipalgad Fort is in the Chandgad taluka of Kolhapur district, of Maharashtra. This fort is an important fort in Kolhapur district. The fort is situated on the mountain ridge close to the line dividing Maharashtra and Karnataka state. The fort is amidst dense evergreen forest.

> Godchinamalaki Falls 40 km from JNMC



This falls is situated near the famous Gokak Falls. It is another picturesque waterfall worth visiting. The surrounding natural beauty makes it an ideal spot for nature lovers and photographers

Kapileshwar Temple 4.5 km from JNMC



Kapileshwar Temple, considered as South Kashi, is a holy shrine in Belgaum City, dedicated to Lord Shiva imbued with divinity.

Tip: The temple is open for devotees from 5:00 AM to 9:00 PM every day.

Rajhansgad Fort (Yellur) 20km from JNMC



Situated atop a hill , this fort was constructed by the rulers of Ratta Dynasty. This fort can be accessed by a short uphill trek to reach the majestic fort entrance or can reach there by vehicle. This fort offers picturesque views of surrounding landscape. Devotees can offer prayers at the Shiva temple.

> Amboli Waterfall 65 km from JNMC

Amboli Waterfall is a picturesque waterfall located near the hill station of Amboli in the Indian state of Maharashtra. It is situated amidst the dense forests of the Western Ghats. It's easily accessible by road. when the water low is at its peak. Apart from enjoying the waterfall,



Near By Places to Visit :

Kolhapur Mahalaxmi Temple Distance from Belagavi: 114 km.



Dedicated to Goddess Mahalaxmi, this 7th-century temple is a revered pilgrimage site in Kolhapur. Its architecture features intricate carvings and sculptures. The temple symbolizes Shakti worship and attracts millions of devotees annually.



A state with Many beautiful Beaches, Old Goa Church known for its Portuguese heritage, Bom Jesus, which houses the relics of St. Francis Xavier.

Dudh Sagar Water Falls Distance from Belagavi: 100 km.



A spectacular view for the domestic and foreign tourists is the Mandovi River spouting down from the steep side of the mountain from over 1017 feet. The Mandovi River originates on the Deccan Plateau in Karnataka and finds its way through the Western Ghats.

Gokarna Distance from Belagavi: 213 km.



A popular pilgrimage destination for Hindus, it's known for sacred sites like Mahabaleshwar Temple, which has a shrine dedicated to the deity Shiva. Nearby, Koti Teertha is a temple tank where devotees wash in the holy waters. The town is also home to beaches such as palm-lined Gokarna, in the center, plus Kudle and Om farther south.



A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Hampi was once the capital of the Vijayanagara Empire. It features stunning ruins, including the Virupaksha Temple, Vittala Temple, and stone chariots. The archaeological site reflects rich cultural heritage and architecture. **Gol Gumbaz** Distance from Belagavi: 202 km.



Located in Bijapur (Vijayapura), Gol Gumbaz is the mausoleum of Sultan Muhammad Adil Shah. Its dome is the second-largest in the world and known for its whispering gallery, where even soft sounds can be heard across the structure.

Badami Distance from Belagavi: 140 km.



Famous for its rock-cut cave temples, Badami was the capital of the Chalukya dynasty. The sandstone cliffs and intricate carvings in the caves, particularly dedicated to Lord Vishnu, Shiva, and Jain deities, are its highlights.



Dandeli is a popular adventure sports destination in Karnataka due to white water rafting opportunities in the Kali riverKali River in Dandeli offers a rafting stretch of up to 12 kms. The stretch of river is covered with dense forests, offers several grade 2 and grade 3 rapids making the rafting experience exhilarating & adventurous. Murdeshwar Distance from Belagavi: 270 km.



is a town in Uttara Kannada district in the state of Karnataka, India, and lies on the coast of the Laccadive Sea. It contains the world's third tallest Shiva statue, as well as the Murudeshwara Temple. The town has a railway station on the Mangalore–Mumbai Konkan railway route.
